4. New Business:

A. Consider WD Accident:

1. Wilkey, Dusty (10/15/2019)

Mr. Wilkey was accompanied by Safety Rep Ricky Botts
Wilkey explained that the lid was covered with water and he did not see it.
Brown asked how fast he was going
Wilkey replied around 8 or 9mph.
Wright asked if he knew the man hole was there
Wilkey replied that he did

Motion made by Wright with a second by Miller to rule this as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points minus (1) point due to low cost of damage.

2. Grudger, Jordan (10/28/2019)

Safety Rep Ricky Botts explained that Grudger was pulling the truck forward to park for lunch when it got hung up on a tree limb damaging the tarp & frame.
