## Meeting Highlights from July 28, 2020

- Council approved a request from the Women That Vote Arts Corporation to install a sculpture, three benches, light fixture and landscaping in Shelper Park.
- City Council approved Hotel/Motel Tax funding agreements with the Lawton Fort Sill Economic Development Corporation, Lawton Fort Sill Chamber of Commerce, Lawton Farmers Market Institute, Lawton Heritage Association, Lawton Philharmonic Society, Inc., and the Museum of the Great Plains.
- Council authorized City staff to create a council policy establishing a citizens' advisory board for the purpose of working with the police department to find ways to facilitate interaction between the citizens of Lawton and the police department.
