Meeting Highlights from September 09, 2020

- Lawton Mayor Stan Booker gave his annual **State of the City** address.
- Council approved a contract with EST for a Corridor Pavement Evaluation Study of SW Lee Blvd from SW 97th St to I-44 and SW Goodyear Blvd from SW Lee Blvd to NW Cache Road.
- Council approved an Agreement for Limited Services between the Museum of the Great Plains Trust Authority and the City of Lawton to fund the continued operation of the museum.
