

Bulky Waste Set-Out Guidelines

Regarding the City of Lawton Residential Solid Waste Collection Plan, beginning 4/5/21

What we can pick up:

1. Large and small household appliances (washers, dryers, water heaters, barbecue grills, etc.)
2. Refrigerators and air conditioners (refrigerant evacuated by licensed HVAC professional)
3. Mattresses
4. Tree debris (lengths of 6' or less, and max. 24" in diameter)
5. Bagged yard waste (leaves, grass clippings)
6. Fencing materials (fence panels 6' x 8' or less)
7. Lumber (lengths of 6' or less)
8. Furniture (couches, chairs, tables)
9. Electronics
10. Cardboard boxes (loose items in boxes must be secured)
11. Carpet and padding

What we cannot pick up:

1. Automotive fluids (antifreeze, transmission fluid, etc.)
2. Automotive repair items (tires, rims, frames, auto parts, etc.)
3. Automotive batteries
4. Bricks
5. Concrete
6. Construction debris (uncontained sheetrock, dirt, rocks, etc.)
7. Liquid waste of any kind
8. Fuel storage items (fuel cans, propane tanks, etc.)
9. Hazardous waste/chemicals
10. Oils (automotive, household, or cooking oils, etc.)
11. Paints and solvents
12. Tires
13. Medical wastes (soiled linens, home health products, etc.)
14. Windows or glass items
15. Bagged, loose, or scattered household trash (place bagged household trash in cart)
16. Explosives
17. Pool chemicals

What does 4 Cubic Yards look like?

EXAMPLES:

1. Four washing machines
2. Four shopping carts
3. Two standard-sized refrigerators
4. Three queen mattresses
