Meeting Highlights from May 25, 2021

- City Council approved the city's budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022.
- City Council received a briefing from Recyclops concerning a potential recycling program for residential and commercial businesses. Partnership opportunities will be explored.
- Council tabled a discussion on reinstatement and revision of the fee structure for the Lake Lawtonka Recreation Area. Discussion will continue at the next regular meeting on June 8, 2021.
