## Meeting Highlights from September 28, 2021

- Mayor Stan Booker issued a proclamation proclaiming September 15 through October 15, 2021, as Hispanic Heritage Month.
- Council adopted Ordinance 21-23 adding definitions and establishing zoning requirements for medical marijuana growing, processing, and dispensary facilities.
- Council adopted Ordinance 21-25 authorizing the City to enter into a contract with a collection agency for the provision of collection services for debts and accounts receivable, which includes unpaid utility bills and court fines.
