Meeting Highlights from January 25, 2022

- Council approved an amendment to the Agreement for Funding and Limited Support for the FISTA Development Trust Authority for the 2021-2022 fiscal year to provide an additional \$2.0 million to be used for the renovation of the space formerly known as the “Sears Building” to prepare the space for DoD contractors and other industrial development tenants.
- Council Approved a proposal and agreement with Preservation and Design Studio for the evaluation and preparation of a biddable scope of work for the repair of the Highland Cemetery Entrance Arch.
