Public Notice for Non-Profit Organizations!

January 30, 2022

The City of Lawton is inviting nonprofit organizations to submit proposals for projects to be funded through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. Only fifteen percent of the CDBG grant funds can be expended for public services activities, approximately \$100,000. Please note that requests for funding will be carefully reviewed to ensure application completeness and adherence to required expenditure limitations. It is anticipated that CDBG funds, to be awarded by the Department of Housing and Urban Development, will be available for the 2022-2023 Program Year around October 1, 2022.

CDBG funding can be used for a variety of public service projects and activities that benefit the low-moderate income and disadvantaged residents in our community, including, but not limited to:

- Counseling Services
- Job Training
- After-School Programs
- Crime Prevention Programs
- Homeless Shelters
- Homeless Prevention Programs
- Senior/Disability Services
- Utility/Rental Assistance

The CDBG funding application can be viewed and downloaded from lawtonok.gov/publications/community-development-block-grant-cdbg-program-application. The application must be completed and printed for submittal.

The application will be available on **Monday, February 7, 2022** on the City of Lawton's website. The City of Lawton will be accepting requests for CDBG funding from **March 10, 2022 through April 8, 2022**. All funding request applications must be received by the City of Lawton, Housing & Community Development located at 1405 SW 11th Street, Lawton, OK by **4:00 pm on April 8, 2022**. CDBG funding requests that are incomplete or received after the deadline will not be accepted.

Applications will be reviewed by the City Planning Commission, and the commission will make a recommendation to the Housing & Community Development Administrator to be included in the draft Annual Action Plan.

Applicants will be required to present their application to the City Planning Commission on **April 14, 2022 at 1:30pm in the auditorium at City Hall, 212 SW 9th Street**. This presentation will be 5-10 minutes long and will describe your organization and the project/program you are seeking funding for.
