Meeting Highlights from February 8, 2022

- Council adopted Ordinance 22-09 revising and adding definitions and revising procedures for the collection and disposal of refuse, trash, and bulky waste. Read more about these guidelines in the city's [Set Out Guide](#).
- Council approved Resolution 22-52 amending Appendix A, Schedule of Fees and Charges, removing the optional house-side residential cart collection fee for non-disabled; establishing fees for refuse cart relocation; premium cart collection; overloaded cart collection; short-term container service; premium bulky waste collection; and excess residential bulky waste collection.
