Updates from Lawton City Council



Meeting Highlights from August 23, 2022

- EXECUTIVE SESSION: Council approved basic terms of the Blue Braveheart project. Click [here](#) to learn more.
- Council voted to approve amending the City Manager's back-to-work Covid-19 incentive. They voted to extend proof of vaccination and booster deadline to 12/31/22, but did not approve incentive pay.
- Council discussed the potential de-annexation of the area located at Bishop Road & 67th Street & approved the plan proposed by Public Utilities. The plan is to extend the 12" and 8" public water main line, which will be funded from the 2019 Water & Sewer CIP. Council also accepted the Fire Marshal's plan to service the area in the interim time period to include any floor amendment made.
- Council adopted an ordinance establishing a three-day vessel permit for boats & established rules & regulations for paddleboats & canoes.
