Updates from Lawton City Council



Meeting Highlights from August 9, 2022

- Council approved an agreement for Funding and Limited Support with the Fires Innovation Science and Technology Accelerator (FISTA) Development Trust Authority in the amount of \$4,952,903.98. \$1.64 million will cover the Authority's operations and the note payment for Central Mall.
- Council approved naming the drive that leads to East Side Park "Keith Jackson Parkway" after former councilmember Keith Jackson. [Click here](#) to learn more.
- Council approved the Draft of the FY22 Annual Action Plan with an amendment to the 5-year Consolidated Plan, accepted recommended amounts for Public Service Organization Funding Request Applications, and revisions to Housing and Urban Development funded programs. Council directed staff to bring back a plan for limited years and to include other public service organizations.
