- Council approved a resolution authorizing the installation of traffic control measures at the 1600 block of NW 72nd Street and on NW 75th Street at Willow Creek Park.
- Council awarded a contract to Control Panels USA Inc. to replace the operation and controls Computer operations system and communication systems at both WTPs and Water Distribution.
