Meeting Highlights from September 27, 2022

- EXECUTIVE SESSION: Council directed staff to prepare a cost estimate to address vulnerability issues at Lawton City Hall.
- EXECUTIVE SESSION: Council denied requests for legal services for former Lawton Police officers Nathan Ronan & Robert Hinkle.
- Council adopted resolutions declaring eleven properties to be dilapidated.
- A motion to accept a \$139,058.20 proposal from EverSash LP DBA Old House Rescue to repair the Highland Cemetery Arch failed.
- Council approved a request from the Lawton Youth Sports Authority for \$40,000 to conduct a study of the Lawton area sports market.
