- EXECUTIVE SESSION: Council appointed Councilman Randy Warren to represent City Council in pending action in United States District Court titled City of Lawton v. Engie Services, U.S., Inc. f/k/a OpTerra Energy Services, Inc.
- Council approved a proposal from EverSash LPDBA Old Home Rescue to repair the Highland Cemetery Arch & approved appropriating an additional \$39,058.20 to total just under \$140,000 for repairs.
- Council approved requests from Holiday in the Park to paint two murals on the east pavilion & secure a concrete base for the "LOVE" display within Elmer Thomas Park.
