## Meeting Highlights from December 6, 2022

- Council tabled deciding on the location of a downtown transit center & the maintenance & operations facility after a public hearing.
- Council adopted an ordinance annexing about 160 acres of land into the corporate limits of the City of Lawton.
- Council received a presentation from Halff Associates regarding the status of the Lakes Master Plan.
- Council approved reallocating \$9,425,340 of ARPA Revenue Replacement funds and passed a budget amendment from FY 2023 unallocated 2019 Propel CIP funds in the amount of \$574,660 for an incentive payment of \$10,000,000 to Project Blue Braveheart.
