Meeting Highlights from January 10, 2023

- Ward 8 Councilmember Randy Warren was elected as Mayor Pro Tem.
- Council approved \$261,800 to the Emergency Reserve Fund for the demolition of a burnt nursing home at 1301 NW Andrews Ave.
- Council accepted the donation of an X-ray Machine to Lawton Animal Welfare from DVM Trace Kirkpatrick of Southwest Veterinary Clinic in Porter Hill, OK.
- Council approved a resolution lifting the moratorium on water sales outside of city limits, effective immediately.
- Council approved the demolition of the old Police Station located at 10 SW 4th St.
- Council directed staff to write an RFP for community correction solutions or regional/jail corrections solution for the City & county.
