Updates from Lawton City Council



Meeting Highlights from September 12, 2023

- Approved **Resolution 23-150** amending the City of Lawton FY 2023-2024 budget, as amended, by appropriating \$3,084,814.18 to the Capital Improvements Project Fund/PROPEL.
- Approved **Resolution 23-151** amending the current pay scale for Executive-Level positions by increasing the minimum hourly rate and maximum hourly rate for each executive level, and any adjustments to the Executive Levels, consistent with the recent Compensation and Classification Analysis recommendations. The new pay scale will be retroactively effective July 1, 2023, and will repeal all previous Executive Level Pay Scales.
- Received a report from WTI on options for future aquatics facilities. **Directed staff to interview and select a consultant.**
- Discussed LPD's support of funeral processions as a general matter. Directed staff to continue with the current program.
- Adopted **Ordinance 23-38** prohibiting the use of throw nets in Lake Helen and Liberty Lake.
